## **Important Information for Applicants**

Applications have to be submitted no later than August 7, 2022, 23:59 CET. Please send all documents as PDFs via email to curator Dietmar Kraus at <u>ifef@edimotion.de</u>

To apply, you must be a citizen of, and currently live & work in, one of the countries named in the <u>DAC List of ODA Recipients</u>, published by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD). Exceptions can be made for recently displaced editors, such as a Ukrainian citizen currently exiled in another country.

Applicants should also be active in whatever film editing community structures exist in their countries, be dedicated to improving working conditions and the recognition of the profession there, and be keen to exchange experiences and ideas on this with other film editors from all over the world.

This PDF application form can be filled out digitally, and sent via Email together with the following:

- Letter of motivation (max. 2 pages, with a description of your professional career and current work situation, your personal commitment to the profession, as well as some thoughts on the future development of film editing in your home country).
- Short vita and filmography as an editor with indication of your current focus of life and work.
- A letter of reference (max. 1 page, could be from a film director, a university lecturer, or a colleague).

You can add a few samples of your work (screening links), if you like, but this is not required.

The decision who receives a travel grant will be made by a jury, and announced on 15 August 2022. Before this announcement, grant recipients have to give a binding commitment to participate in the International Film Editors Forum on 15 October 2022.
